# "A New Kind of Normal"



This book follows the journey of Carol and Gene Kent as they watched their comfortable lives take a horrible detour when their beloved son was arrested and eventually sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole. At the time, they could not know that this was only the beginning of a journey that would never again settle into their expectations. From failed appeals to losing their granddaughters, the heartache has not abated. And yet, they have not despaired.

Carol Kent is hilariously funny, biblically sound, and heartbreakingly transparent in person and in print. Founder and president of Speak Up for Hope (a prison ministry) and Speak Up Speaker Services, Carol is an expert on public speaking, writing, and evangelism. She travels the world, speaking to tens of thousands each year at events such as Praise Gathering, Vision New England Congress, THRIVE, Extraordinary Women, Women of Grace, and Women of Faith. And when they are back home in Florida, Carol and her husband, Gene, visit their only son on Sunday afternoons.



I have grown up, and I am now ready to deal with reality and responsibility. I feel if I am released to your program I will learn and accomplish a lot. The only other place I have to go is my mother's home. My mom is still in her addiction, and I don't want to be around anyone that is using. I need and want better things for my children and my life. Please consider me for a chance at life with Christ and staying drug free."

Already, forty-four women have written heart-felt requests for an application to the Patsy's Place program. These women understand that they need help to make the life changes necessary to stay free from crime and drugs and to be good role models for their children. They are clinging to the promise that all things are possible through Christ.

Our completion date has been pushed back to early 2011, but construction continues as walls have come up and colors are being picked out. We are again asking that you make an investment in Patsy's Place as we work to raise the first year's operating funds which will allow us to provide services to an expected 12-18 women each year.
