Sharing Hope Ministry is pleased to welcome April Riggs as its new Executive Director. April is a member of Westcliff Bible Church, where she and her husband serve as volunteer youth ministers. We asked April to share a little bit with you below:

"I'm so thankful that God knows the path that we are to follow. He gives us the desire to be in certain places at His appointed time. As I look back over the last several years, I see how God's hand gently guided me to the position of Executive Director of Sharing Hope Ministry.

"For several years I held the position of the Executive Director of a child advocacy program in Dalhart. In that position, I was able to help the organization in its pursuit to seek recourse for the best interest

of children in the foster care system. For the last four years, I have been the College Director of the ACE programs at Palo Duro High and Caprock High Schools. In this position, I guided high risk seniors and college students with their college applications, and their collegiate performance.
