Sharing Hope Ministry is seeking Christian women to serve as volunteer mentors for the Stepping Stones Aftercare Program. Stepping Stones mentors provide spiritual encouragement and follow-up support for women who have been incarcerated including those living at Patsy's Place Transitional Home.

Stepping Stones Mentors offer one-on-one care while walking alongside a woman when she is hurting, lonely, worried, confused, doubting or lost - all feelings experienced by women who have recently been incarcerated. The mentor's role is to be a listener and encourager. Mentoring is biblical... It is what Jesus commands us to do, "Love one another." Mentors are "care-givers" who help women seek out God as the ultimate "cure-giver."

Interested in Becoming a Mentor?

There is no charge for the training and all materials, notebook, meals and snacks for the days of training.

What amount of time is expected of a mentor?

1 hr. weekly to meet face-to-face with assigned mentee

Once a month for Small Group Peer Supervision (1st Thursday evening of the month)
