Lots of exciting things are happening at The Lucille and Leo Caiafa Center for Advancement!

- We partnered with Amarillo College to host an instructor taught GED class for post offending women. Everything has been provided free to our students.
- Dressing for Impressing was offered to post offending women and other shelter women. This class not only taught women how to dress appropriately for a job or interview, but how to make good eye contact, shake hands, and much more. A free interview outfit, shoes, jewelry, and purse was provided to each attendee.
- We began a 5th week Pantry. This pantry day is offered to graduates and past residents of Patsy's Place, and local post offending women. It is a great resource to help women and families either in a time of need or to provide some relief from their everyday food budget.

Long Range Planning Complete!

After months of prayer, and meetings involving volunteers and staff, our Board of Directors has released our new strategic plan for the next three-five years. Thank you to all who prayed for us!

OUR GOALS:

Goal #1 - Ministry Sustainability

Three areas have been targeted to preserve our ability to fulfill our mission. Actions will be taken to promote financial sustainability, to address future staffing needs, and to ensure adequate technology.

Goal #2 - Program Enhancement

The current services provided by Sharing Hope Ministry are impactful and life-changing, but we can do more!

- Prison and jail ministries -We will be adding the Spanish *Life Recovery Bible* and materials to address the growing Spanish speaking population.
- Patsy's Place Transitional Home -Individual plan of actions will be created for each woman. New forms and curriculums will be available to our staff and volunteers, and changes will be made to our program requirements.
- Center for Advancement -This program has opportunities for great growth by adding more evening classes and resources. We have already added GED classes for post-offending women and a 5th week food pantry.
- Other - we are researching opportunities to provide limited services to offending female juveniles and to human trafficking victims who are at-risk for being incarcerated.

Goal #3 - Extended Aftercare

We are excited to share our ideas of helping more women when they are released from incarceration and we have several objectives:

- Prison and Jail ministries -upon request, aftercare packets will be sent to Texas women who have recently been released from incarceration. These packets will have resource lists for local, recovery and spiritual resources, a plan of action for starting their new life, and tips about triggers for addicts.
- Patsy's Place Transitional Home -We will improve communication with graduates and past participants for ongoing support, and to provide opportunities to be involved with the ministry.
- Center for Advancement -We are researching the option of providing more aftercare assistance to women as they are being released from Potter and Randall County Jail.

OUR BIG, SCARY, AUDACIOUS GOAL - History has shown that God has always had big plans for Sharing Hope Ministry so our planning sessions includes the "out of the ballpark" dream. Almost every group that participated in this planning session stated that they would love to see either a sober-living facility for our graduates or expansion of the Patsy's Place program. For now, we wait and pray for God's leading, and that He prepares and strengthens us.

We Have Been Incredibly Blessed in 2019



We were given \$7,500 by CNS Pantex! Receiving this grant means being able to continue to provide quality classes, shelter for the women of Patsy's Place,

and outreach to families of the incarcerated or addicted in our community.

Accidents happen, and this time the accident involved someone running a red-light and hitting our transportation van for the Patsy's Place women. No one was hurt but our poor van is no longer with us.
